Answer response questions.
2/Aug. 23	Discussion; intro to MLA format; American Romanticism	Read “The Devil and Tom Walker”, “Mr. Heidegger’s Experiment”, and “The Raven”. Answer response questions.
3/Aug. 30	Discussion	Read poems by Walt Whitman and excerpts by Louisa May Alcott, and Fredrick Douglass. Answer response questions.
4/Sept. 14	Discussion; Realism and Naturalism; MLA format	Read “The Most Remarkable Woman of This Age”, “An Occurrence at Owl Creek Bridge”, “The Mystery of Heroism”, “I Will Fight No More Forever”, “The Lowest Animal”, “Story of an Hour”, “To Build a Fire,” and “We Wear the Mask”. Answer response questions.
